New Guidelines Available for PennDOT's Agility Program

PennDOT's Agility Program allows eligible partners to exchange services with one another. One of the biggest advantages of the Agility Program is that long-term relationships are developed between partners and PennDOT, and limited resources can be stretched between these qualifying organizations.

Eligible partners include local governments, councils of governments, volunteer fire departments, state and federal agencies, non-profit ambulance and rescue companies, school districts, and charitable hospitals.
