Leadership Huntingdon County Seeks Applicants for the Class of 2009

Leadership Huntingdon County includes a variety of educational approaches including lecture, field trips, skill building, "hands on" experience, team work, fact finding, and problem solving for issues facing our community. Issues that will be examined will include local government, tourism, transportation, economic development, health care, human services, arts and heritage.

The Leadership Huntingdon County class will meet one evening per month from September through May. To kick off the program there will be an evening reception and one-day retreat early in September. Two field trips to locations within the county are planned. The fall field trip will focus on learning about the County's heritage, while the spring field trip will focus on recreation and tourism. Tuition for the program is \$450.
